**REQUIREMENT 1:** Using X-ray (radiographic) films or images and with your counselor's guidance, do the following:

**REQUIREMENT 1a:** Study the tooth structure and look for decay.

**REQUIREMENT 1c:** Show on your drawing where the nerves and blood vessels enter and leave the tooth.

**REQUIREMENT 1d:** Show on your drawing where bacterial plaque is most likely to be found.



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**REQUIREMENT 2a:** Tell or write about what causes dental decay and gum disease.
